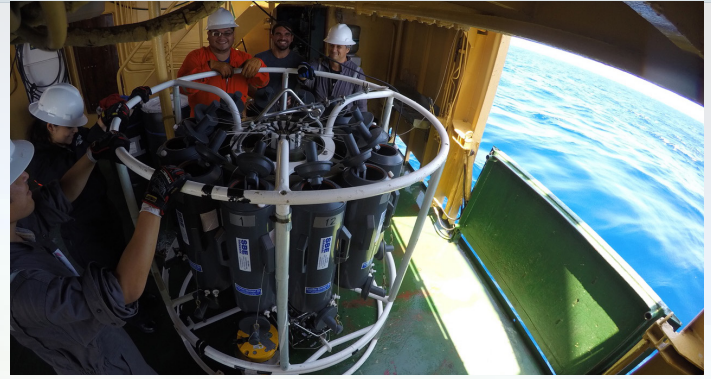


GCOOS Spring Webinar Series presents

Southern Gulf of Mexico Marine Observations, Research and Technology: Opportunities for Gulf-Wide Synergies and Cooperation



Join the Gulf of Mexico Coastal Ocean Observing System (GCOOS), Texas A&M University (TAMU), the Network-to-Network for the Gulf of Mexico (N2N-GoM) and the Society for Underwater Technology-US (SUT-US) as we invite colleagues from two major Mexican marine research consortia to share information about their basic and applied research in the southern Gulf of Mexico.
